

Most Blessed Sacrament Parish Catechesis of the Good Shepherd COVID-19 Procedures

All attendees will be asked to comply with any current Diocesan guidelines and governmental laws.

A hospitality minister will be stationed at the entrance and their role is to:

- Take guests temperatures, provide hand sanitizer and offer face masks for those who wish to wear them
- Warmly welcome those who are coming
- Offer directions to those who are not sure where to go
- Sanitize surfaces such as door handles and stair rails

In the Atrium:

- Catechists, Aides and volunteers will wear masks when within 6 feet of children, parents or guests (masks may be taken off when giving presentations from a distance)
- All materials will be sanitized after each person has worked with it. To do this, children will be shown how to place a red card on a material after they use it. An aide will sanitize the materials and then remove the red card so that children know the material is available for them to use.
- As much as possible, children will work in their own spaces
- Hand sanitizer as well as a hand washing station will be available for the children to use throughout the session
- Each session will be limited to 12 children

After each session:

- All commonly touched surfaces will be sanitized

These guidelines are subject to change depending on the evolving local circumstances related to the coronavirus.
